ACTIVITIES

1. Managed Community Clinic at Mohan Kumar Nagar on daily basis from the Year 1999 to 2007 in association with M S Ramaiah Medical College and Rotary Club Northwest.
2. Health Education to the Adolescents by publishing book "Niranthara" and distributed them to the college students free of cost.
3. Adopted 15 Govt. Schools in and around Bengaluru, visit them periodically with team of Doctors from M S Ramaiah Medical College to assess the students for nutritional aspects, Chronic Diseases, Oral hygiene and provide treatment to the needy. This was for a period of 12 years.
4. Adopted 3 Govt. Schools & 1 School for disabled (deaf and dumb) to Monitor their health on weekly basis.
5. **Established Community Clinic** in the year 2006 at Gunjur village to treat villagers on weekly basis. Senior physicians Dr. Vatsala, Dr. Padma Nanjappa & Dr. Sumangala Rao have offered voluntary services to treat the visiting patients, this was for a period of 12 years.
6. The Trust on its own visits Schools to Screen children with the help from Refractionists and provide spectacles to the needy.
7. As facilitator to "SANKARA EYE HOSPITAL" Bengaluru., we organized Eye camps for Govt. Schools students at their premises to screen & treat around 35,000 of them annually, for three years.



8. As facilitator to Endocrinology & Diabetes Research Trust (R), identified Rural Govt. Schools & distributed Education Materials worth Rs.15 Lakhs annually for three years to the students.
9. Since the academic year 2012-13 Doctors from "KLE Society's College of Dental Sciences & Sri Krishnadevaraya College of Dental Sciences are taken to identified Rural Govt. Schools of Chikkaballapura, Ramanagara and Bangalore Rural Districts to Screen & Treat schools' Children for Dental Ailments by conducting Camps at their premises. On average of 17,000 Students are being screened annually
10. Produced Short film Dantha Suraksha to create awareness with regard to Oral Hygiene. This film was produced in association with M S Ramiah Dental College & Sarva Shikshana Abhyana.



DVDs were distributed to beneficiaries, free of cost.

11. A short film "Arivu, Jeevanadalli - Tiruvu" depicting various aspects of Health & Environment has been produced and DVDs were distributed to Rural Schools. This was materialized with the association of KLE Society's Institute of Dental Sciences & Sarva Shikshana Abhyana"
12. Initiated, conducted awareness programme on the importance of "Breast Feeding" among girl students of various Colleges in Bangalore in association with Dr. Dayananda (dept. of Community Medicine), Dr. Mallikarjun (dept. of Pediatrics) MSRMC & Prof. Kodandaramaiah (Director Collegiate Education) This programme was the initiative of "Breast feeding Promotion Network of India". Dr. Dayananda & Dr. Mallikarjun earned "BEST Resource Person" Award by virtue of their efforts.



13. Conducted medical clinic for senior citizens at "FEDINA" in Kammanahalli twice a week for seven years with the help of Hon. Dr.Raghavendra Rao and provided them medicines on his advice.
14. Collect Medicines (physician samples) from philanthropic doctors periodically, donate them to Sri Vivekananda Clinic at Sharada Mutt, premises, Ulsoor, where poor patients visit daily. Two doctors diagnose these patients and provide them medicines free of cost.
15. Under the aegis of Bangalore Society of Obstetrics & Gynecology Bangalore-52, Camps were conducted with the association of Dr. Sundari and Dr. Prasanna Kumar KM for girl children of age group 12 to 16 years (onset of Menarche) to assess their anemic conditions by analyzing blood for RBC. Number of children screened during the camp were around 6,000. These girls were the students of Govt. High School from Bangalore Urban and villages of Magadi taluk. Identified Anemics were treated with medicines. General Medical & Dental Screening and Treatment Camp were also conducted for these girls during the same period. These Camps were held during the Academic year 2008-09.
16. Trust built 3 toilets at its own cost for girl students in Govt. School premises in Santebeedi, Yeswantpur as they skipped school quite often due to non availability of toilet facilities for them. This service helped them to improve their scholastic performance.
17. Associated with Dr. Prasanna Kumar KM endocrinologist to identify Juvenile diabetics among school going children in Bangalore, at their School premises. Blood samples were collected from them for fasting blood sugar analysis. Around 6,000 students were screened in this programme.
18. Two Camps were conducted for villagers in association with Dr. Prasanna Kumar KM, Dr. Eldose T. Vargese Medical Officer PHC, at Koppa, Sringeri and Harihara pura



(villages of Chikkamagalur district) in the area of general medical and Dental health. Doctors from M S Ramaiah Medical & Dental Colleges (dept. of Community Medicine & dept. of Public Health Dentistry) attended these Camps to provide the villagers their voluntary, dedicated services to alleviate the sufferings of the beneficiaries.

19. The Trust in association with KLE SOCIETY INSTITUTE of Dental Sciences, Bengaluru, has published picturesque book "Dantha Samhitha" in kannada on Oral/Dental hygiene to create awareness among school children through teachers and distributed 20,000 copies to about 18,000 schools in 10 Districts of karnataka.
20. The Trust by virtue of its dedicated community services, in coordination with Philanthropic Donors, Service providers and Beneficiaries for the past 24 years has earned many accolades, on behalf of the TRUST, some of which are produced here with.
21. Creating awareness on health issues for the rural students by conducting Medical Camps on a regular basis and for its various activities enlisted above.
22. Provided diabetes related medicines worth Rs. 2,70,000/- to EDRT ® for providing free treatment to poor juvenile diabetic children during 2021-22.
23. Provided Rs. 52,000/- worth dental research Material to "Destined to Serve" ®, Wholly Charitable Trust to Encourage Scientific Research to enable poor community to get Quality dental implants at affordable Cost.
24. Instrumental in getting Rs. 7 Lakhs as CSR Contribution to Mahati ® Wholly Charitable Trust to rural women for "Cervical Cancer" free of cost.
25. Trust is represented as one of the Members in the Institution Ethical Committee of KLE Society College of Dental Sciences, Bengaluru, Krishnadevaraya College of Dental Sciences Hunsmaranahalli, Bengaluru., for the past several years, as Social Scientist. The IEC is formed to approve research projects



presented by the Post Graduate students as a part of the circular to obtain Masters Degree. Also Ethical Committee Member of Bengaluru Endocrinology and Diabetics Research Center and University of Trans-Disciplinary Health Science, Jarakabande Kaval, Bengaluru.

26. The Trust was a representative of Regional committee for bringing changes/amendments to Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical Research On human subject, constituted by Indian Council of Medical Research, New Delhi.

The Trust has not employed any person on salary.

Medicines for treatment are procured at concessional rates from “Shankeshwar Pharma”, Distributors in Bangalore.

The Trust so far has not established any Corporate funding on regular basis, nor there is any Govt. source for its finances.

The Trust is indebted to Philanthropic Donors, Eminent Doctors, Our Auditors, Department of Education, Dr. Prasanna Kumar KM for his valuable guidance & also to the Beneficiaries for their acceptance of the Trust’s dedicated services as a team.
